

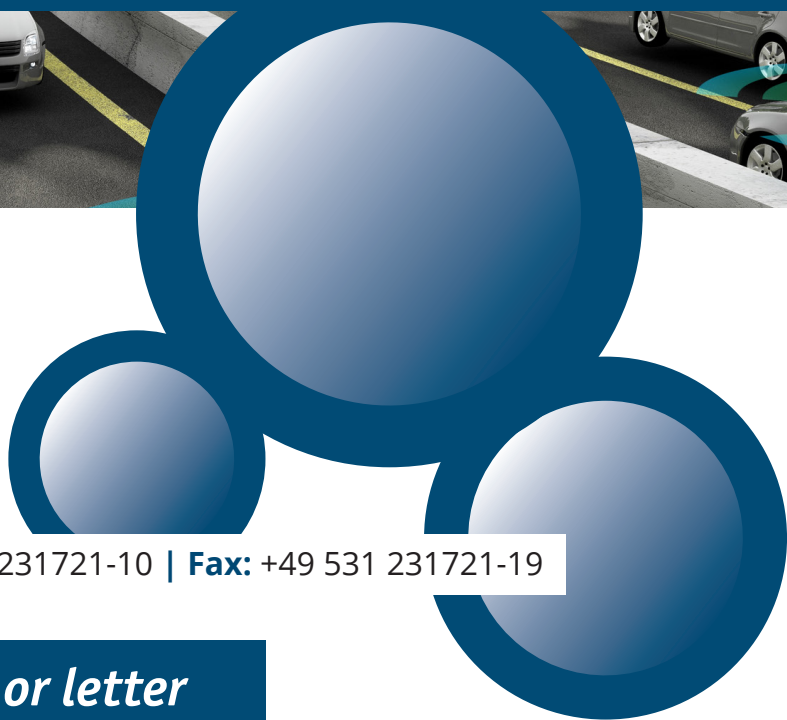

Terms and Conditions for the CAR 2 CAR Communication Consortium Subscription Service between the organisation [receiver of the Subscription Service] and the CAR 2 CAR Communication Consortium [the consortium].

1. Approval Initiation of Subscription Service

The request of the organisation to receive the Subscription Service of the CAR 2 CAR Communication Consortium shall be processed by the consortium within two weeks from having received the filled-in application form. The

consortium develops an invoice on the ordered Subscription Service and sends the pdf-invoice by e-mail to the indicated contact person of the receiver. The Subscription Service will not start until the Subscription Service fee is transferred by the organisation to the consortium.

2. Subscription Service Rights

The indicated contact person of the receiver of the Subscription Service will have access to the members' download area on the CAR 2 CAR website, this includes also access to the published electronic journals. The contact person is allowed to share the information within his/her organisation. The log-in data as well as the information of the Subscription Service must not be passed to third parties. The organisation will not have the right to transfer data received from the consortium to third parties. Beyond these services there will be no other services available. Furthermore, the organisation will not have the right to use the CAR 2 CAR trademark.

3. Start and End of Subscription Service

The Subscription Service of the consortium is for one calendar year starting on 1 January and ending on 31 December. For extending the Subscription Service the organisation has to apply once more by filling-in a new application form.

4. Subscription Service Fee

Subscription Service of the consortium is subject to an annual fee. The Subscription Service fee is 880.00 EUR plus VAT (currently 19%) per year payable in advance. The Subscription Service fee is invoiced from the beginning of the calendar year the Subscription Service shall be used.

5. Intellectual Property Rights and liability

No interest, license or any other right regarding the Intellectual Property of a Consortium Member or of the consortium is granted to the receiver of the Subscription Service under these terms and conditions.

6. Data use

The Organisation ensures that persons authorised to process the personal data have committed themselves to confidentiality or are under an appropriate statutory obligation of confidentiality.

7. Other

7.1 These terms and conditions shall be construed in accordance with and governed by the Laws of Germany. All disputes arising out of or in connection with the present terms and conditions shall be finally settled under the Rules of Arbitration of the International Chamber of Commerce by one or more arbitrators appointed in accordance with the said Rules. The number of arbitrators shall be three. The Chairman shall be of juridical education. The place of arbitration shall be Frankfurt a. M. (Germany). The arbitral proceedings shall be held in English.

7.2 Should any provision of these terms and conditions prove to be invalid or incapable of fulfilment, or subsequently become invalid or incapable of fulfilment, whether in whole or in part, this shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of these terms and conditions. In such a case, the Parties shall be entitled to demand that a valid and practicable provision be negotiated which most nearly fulfils the purpose of the invalid or impracticable provision.

2. Responsible authority and purpose of data processing

3. Receiver of the data

The CAR 2 CAR Communication Consortium fosters international cooperation

4. Duration of data storing

The personal data will be stored for the duration of the subscription. After termination of the subscription, the personal data will be deleted following the end of the legal retention period.

5. Rights of the applicant

The applicant a) is entitled to obtain information of the responsible authority about whether concerned personal data are processed; if this is the case, then the applicant has the right of information about these personal data (Art. 15 GDPR), b) has the right of rectification in case of personal data wrongly gathered (Art. 16 GDPR), c) has a right to erasure of the personal data (Art. 17 GDPR), to limitation of processing (Art. 18 GDPR), of appeal to a supervisory authority (Art. 77 GDPR) and to data portability (Art 20 GDPR).
